Overview

This course consists of a unit of competency in the Resources and Infrastructure Training Package; the theoretical component is delivered in a classroom environment, encouraging interaction and knowledge sharing between participants.

Participants must have access to an active worksite in order to complete practical application of skills, providing evidence of this through the completion of a work logbook and workplace assessment.

Who is this course for?

This course is targeted at existing employees of civil construction, mining or extractive industries. Participants must hold a Medium Rigid licence in order to operate the machine.

Participants must have literacy and numeracy skills to the level of completing documents and forms and to be able to manage own work time.

Course content

- Workplace roles and responsibilities
- Hazards, risks, emergency procedures and reporting
- Inspections, fault finding and equipment security
- Safe operating techniques

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course participants should be able to:

- Identify and communicate roles and responsibilities of fellow workers and self
- Locate emergency and personal protective equipment and understand its use
- Apply operational maintenance and basic diagnostics
- Recognise signs of fatigue and understand how this should be managed
- Safely and consistently operate machine to workplace standards

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Assessment

Participants engage in:

- Problem solving activities and scenarios
- Short answer questions - written
- Group participation
- Work type activities
- Completion of a logbook
- Observation of practical skills

Award

This is a nationally recognised training program. Participants who successfully complete the assessment for this course will receive a Nationally Accredited Statement of Attainment for the unit of competency outlined above.

Course duration

1 day in the classroom

Final assessment to take place in the workplace within 30 days
