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Compliance – The Compliance Manager

Unit of Competency:

- TLIF0007 Manage a fatigue risk management system
- TLIF4066 Implement and supervise transport regulations compliance systems

Overview

This course consists of units of competency in the Transport and Logistics Training Package; it is delivered in a classroom environment, encouraging interaction and knowledge sharing between participants.

This course is targeted at senior management, compliance managers, directors, board members and auditors of freight forwarding companies whose role includes responsibility for compliance by the Regulator or who may be held professionally or personally responsible under CoR. These persons may be defined as a 'relevant party' under Heavy Vehicle National Law and are required to satisfy the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator Fatigue Management Accreditation legislation.

Who is this course for?

Pentrans Consulting recommends this course for those who have extensive experience operating under Compliance Management Systems in the transport industry.

Participants must have:

- Current access to an active worksite
- Analytical skills to identify features of compliance systems as applied to the workplace
- Strong literacy skills in order to interpret Regulations
- Familiarity with technology required to manage systems

Course content

- Regulation, legislation, permits, licences

 - Fatigue management
 - Mass, dimension and loading

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- State/territory and national regulations
- Vehicle standards
- Strategies for managing and maintain compliance systems

Learning outcomes

On completion of the course participants should be able to:

- Interpret instructions, procedures, regulations and implementation material
- Identify and access relevant regulations, legislation and workplace procedures
- Identify and access sources of information to enable implementation and completion of procedures, documents and logs
- Ensure continuous improvement and implementation of policies, procedures and documentation to manage compliance system
- Supervise monitoring of consequence under regulation and legislation

Assessment

- Work based project

Course duration
